Sunnyvale Garden Club was formed in 1974 by Rosemary Hinman. She was the driving force behind the club which was then called Sunnyvale Indoor & Outdoor Gardening Groups, for both a daytime and an evening club! By 1979, we had a permanent meeting place at the Arboretum Workroom on the grounds of the Sunnyvale Community Center. Later on, we moved our meetings to the present location. We continue to have a mutually supportive relationship with the City of Sunnyvale.

In 1977, our goal was to continue to learn more about "Our Garden Earth", how to keep it and how to enjoy it. Today, our conservation pledge:
